To Guidance Counselors and Seniors:

All qualifying individuals may apply for the NJSSAR Scholarship. The recipient will receive \$1,000.00. It would be advisable for the Guidance Department to photocopy the set of blank application papers enclosed and keep them on file to supply to interested seniors.

To apply for the scholarship applicants must:

1. Be a male descendent of an SAR/DAR Patriot Ancestor.
2. Plan to attend or be attending an accredited college or university in the United States.
3. Be a citizen of the United States.
4. Need financial assistance.
5. Attach transcripts of grades.
6. Return FOUR copies of the application complete with attachments.
7. Include letters of recommendation from (A) Minister, Priest, or Rabbi; (B) Instructor or Counselor; (C) Neighbor or Employer.

Note: When original application is completed, photocopy it with all attachments to provide the necessary FOUR sets.
